The integrated personality

1. Lower and higher personality integration – self-actualization versus soul infusion (motive)
2. The integrated personality arises out of the coordination of the three personality vehicles
3. Body, emotions and mind act together as one, directed by the central observing and acting director. (we are not the body...)
4. Personalities stand out; they are outstanding within their field. They are self-regulated, self-reliant, and independent individuals. A one-pointed force in the world.

The integrated personality (1)

Selfish personality integration around a single desire

- Integration through pursuing more recognition, popularity, love affairs, personal power etc.
- One or more dominant desires create the one-pointed personality.
- Dominant focus of consciousness: a powerful solar plexus which uses other chakras as means.
- Relates to Mars and personality ray

Selfish personality integration around creativity

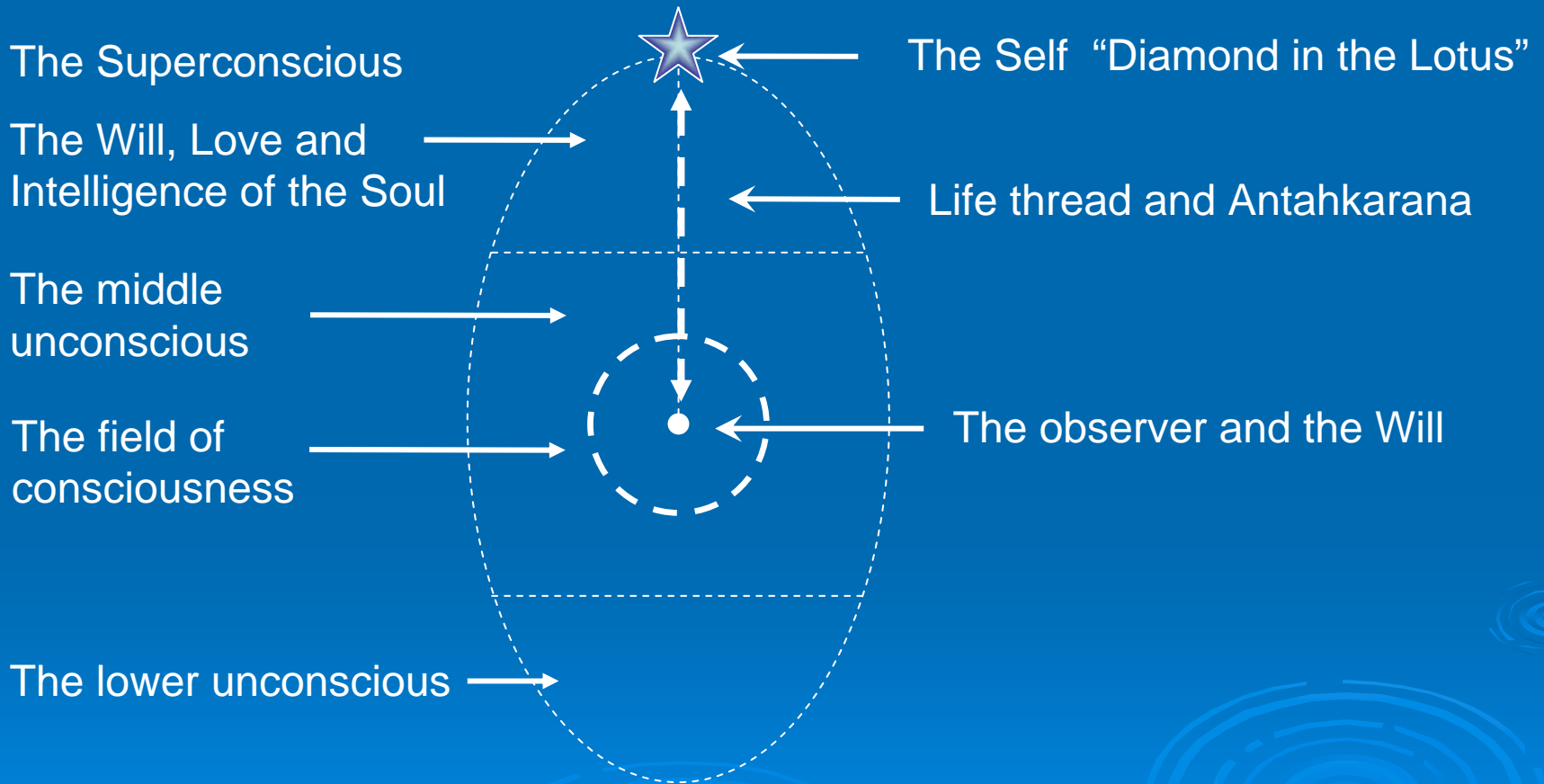
- Correspond to self-actualisation and personal psychosynthesis. Basic needs has been gratified
- The highly intelligent, efficient and mentally polarised human being that set his mark in the world.
- Integration around personality ray and sun sign.
- Dominant focus of consciousness: a powerful throat center which uses other chakras as means.

The integrated personality (4)

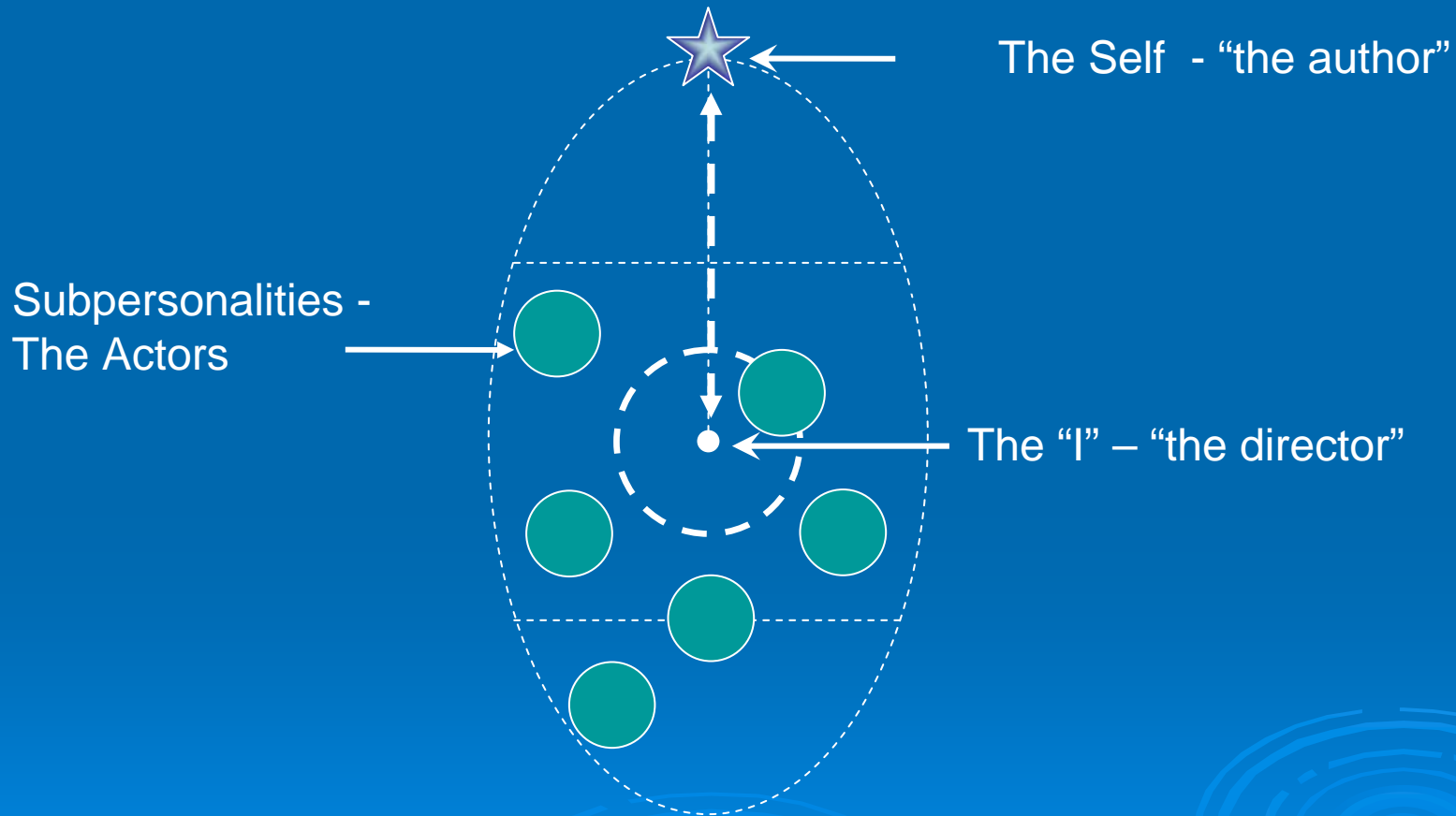
Correspond to spiritual psychosynthesis and **soul fusion**.

- Integration through service to humanity and by transforming the self-centred motivations.
- Synthesis and fusion by aligning the personality ray with the soul ray. Overcoming the glamour's of both.
- The highly intelligent and mentally polarised human with a spiritual service oriented motivation.
- Dominant Ajna and heart center.
- Relates to Venus and Jupiter

Assagioli's Egg Diagram

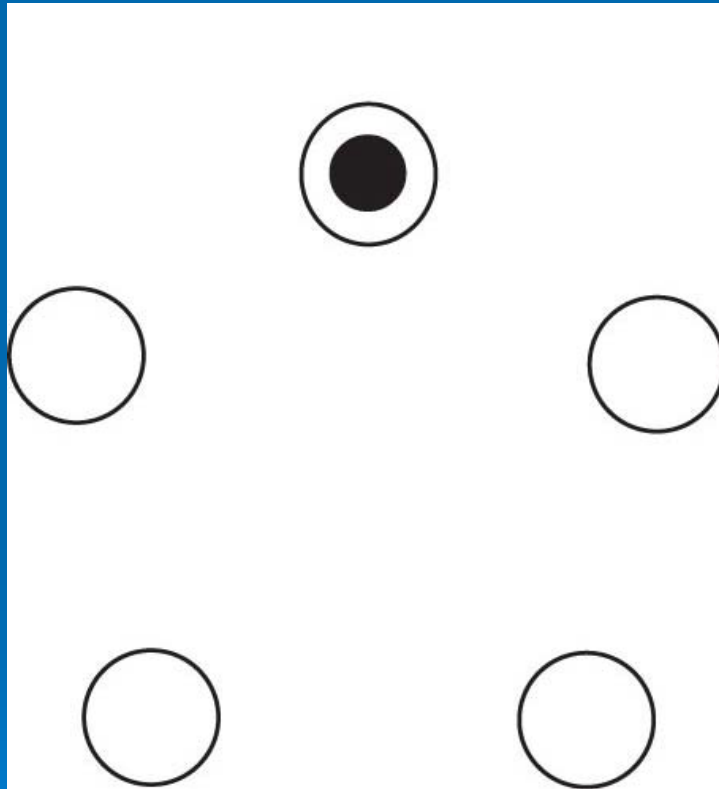

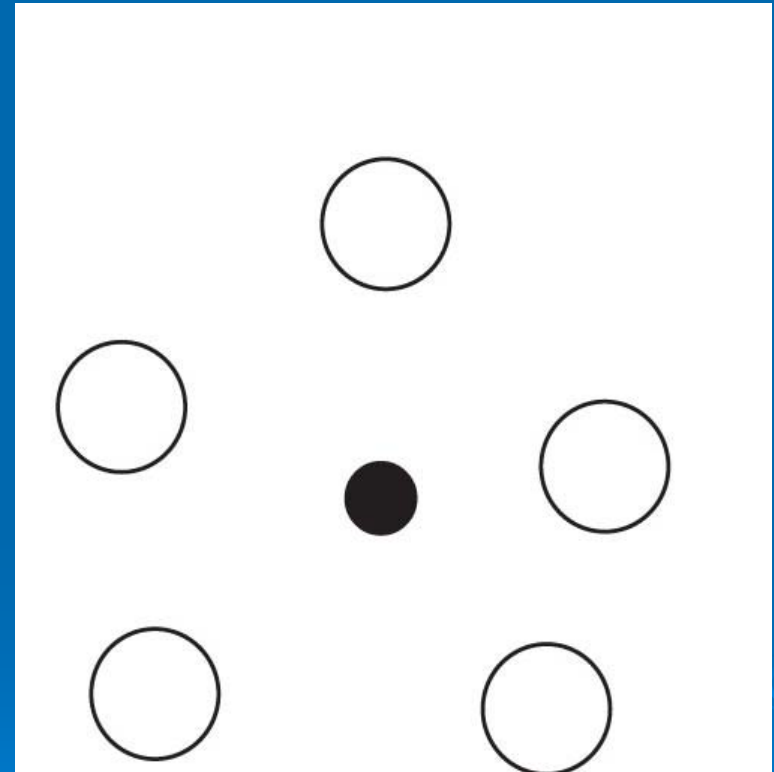


Self-Identification

The unconscious self

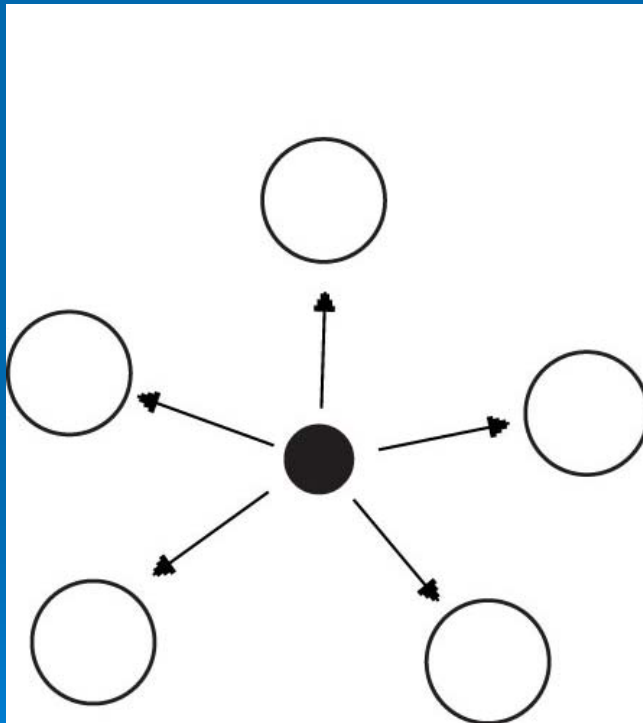


The detached observer

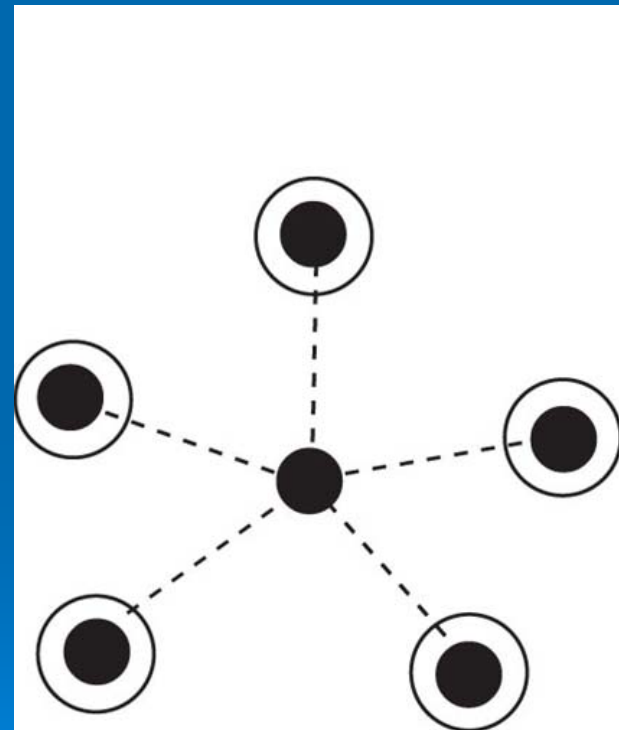


Self-Identification

Lack of integration

“We lack integration whenever we experience a part of our selves we cannot master with our will”.

- Body: food, sex, money, comfort. Emotion: fear, hatred, love and power. Mind: Pride, separateness, cruelty.
- Solution:
Detach (turn subject into object),
Accept (Love object)
Transcend (Find transpersonal potential and transmute)
